# Collector takes stock of work at pumping stations

THE Ariyalur district Collector A Saravanelraj on Monday inspected the work being undertaken at the drinking water supply overhead tanks, pumping stations and bore wells and water gathering wells in Tirumanur Panchayat union, Nadhiyanur, Vaippur - Tha. Pazhur and Jeyamkondam areas in the district.

Speaking during the inspection he said: Works are being undertaken in Ariyalur district as a precautionary exercise to deal with the drinking water situation during the upcoming summer season through the TWAD department.

Around 713680 litres of water is drawn from a deep bore well in a 4.5 metre width and 8 metre deep well at Nadhiyanur on Kollidam bed and supplies the same to Tirumanur union, villages in Tha. Pazhur and Jeyamkondam unions and the tiny villages in the over 20 town panchayats. Precautionary measures are being taken to reach the basic need of drinking water to people in all villages.

The TWAD board engineer has been asked to speed up the maintenance works of bore wells, the Collector said.

During this inspection, the TWAD Board executive engineer Krishnamurthy, Project officer (Mahalir Thittam) Kadiravan, Assistant Executive Engineer Naganand, Waterbodies inspector Dharmalingam, Assistant engineer Sivasankaran and other officials were present.
